<u>The Langley House Trust</u> works with those who are at risk of offending, or have offended, establishing positive foundations, so that they can lead crimefree lives and become contributors to society. Projects include semi-independent accommodation, aimed at resettling exoffenders into the community, drug rehabilitation, work with the homeless, and residential training centres where training leading to recognised qualifications is provided.

<u>The Mission to Seafarers</u>, as a Christian agency, ministers in 250 ports to seafarers of all ranks, nationalities and beliefs, who face problems ranging from loneliness and separation from loved ones, to piracy, shipwreck and abandonment. Through a global network of chaplains, staff and volunteers, the Mission offers practical, emotional and spiritual support via ship visits, drop-in centres, and a range of welfare and emergency support services.
